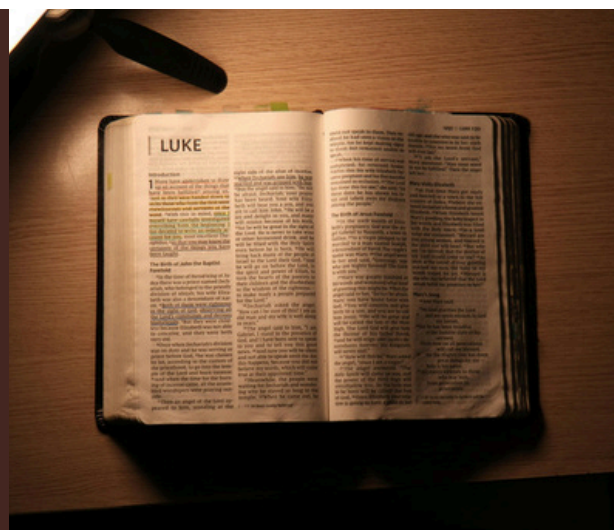
Overview of Program

We're thrilled to launch **Ambassadors for Biblical Justice**, a nine-month virtual mentoring program that trains Christian laypeople to champion a Scripture-rooted vision of justice. You'll gain the wisdom, humility, and practical tools needed to make a real difference in your community—all grounded in the historic Christian worldview.

Vision

In a world torn by division and competing ideas of justice, the Ambassadors for Biblical Justice program equips you with theological clarity and practical tools to unite believers around God's unchanging standards. Rooted in Scripture's command to "do justice, and only justice" (Deut. 16:20), you'll grow confident in advocating biblical justice through curated readings, rich discussions, personal mentorship, and a hands-on capstone project.

Structure

We're now accepting applications for our inaugural 2026–2027 cohort—limited to just 25 participants for an intimate, transformative experience.

This nine-month virtual program runs from August 25, 2026, to May 12, 2027, with live Zoom sessions on the 2nd and 4th Tuesdays at 4 PM PT / 7 PM ET.

You'll:

- Read 1–2 impactful books each month (see sample list below)
- Join facilitated discussions and receive personal mentorship from seasoned Christian leaders
- Participate in three extended workshops on Gospel-centered community renewal
- Design and launch a capstone project—a local justice initiative tailored to your community (e.g., church outreach or service project)

The program fee is \$750, which covers all mentoring sessions, workshops, facilitated discussions, and ongoing support throughout the nine months.
